## Slovak report

Slovakia is in a great personal crisis. Missing doctors and nurses. In hospitals and outpatient clinics. Outpatient doctors work in very old /70-80year/. Study of medicine is an unattractive. Many graduates go abroad. The GP program does not announce many candidates. Retired about 10 per cent of ambulance doctors this year. Despite this bad situation, the Budget for 2019 did not include an increase in payments for undersized outpatient doctors. We carry out many activities to rescue primary care. We managed to partially raise money for the primary sector from 1.1.2019, which should partially consolidate the negative balance of the outpatient salary

GPs are connected to eHealth at 60 percent. from 1.1.2018 is running eHealth. electronical recipes and patient summarys are used. We have succeeded in removing negative law the connection requirement. We are trying to increase the number of competencies that GPs can do at their outpatient clinics. What will bring the greatest amount of work and therefore our goal is to have more than nurse-assistants in our outpatient clinics
